

There are several points for attention in stair renovation. For example, Progress Profiles stair profiles (with anti-slip) protect ceramic, wooden, and laminate

staircase steps at the same time. The anti-slip element is essential for avoiding accidents. One of the latest products is the Prostair Botton, which is made of stainless steel and even rectifies invisible irregularities. Progress Profiles has solutions for all floor installations in just about all materials. For example, there is the licensed Proinsert System, a full range for parquet, wooden floors, laminate, and melamine. The system includes, amongst other things, connecting profiles (SOL 30, SOL 40 P, and SOL 50), transition profiles for floors on different levels and with different thicknesses (ZERO CURVE), end profiles, corner profiles, and stair nosing profiles (STYLE STAIRS). An important accessory is the Progripp, a self-adhesive strip in carborundum, anti-slip, and with high wear resistance. This is available in six colours and widths to meet all technical and aesthetic requirements.

The base of these skirting boards can consist of aluminium, stainless steel, or PVC expanded foam. The inlay is fitted in the factory at Progress Profiles.
